We love you and we will miss you every day.



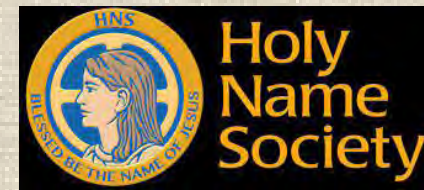
